Sysmex to Voluntarily Adopt International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS)

At a meeting of the Managing Board held today, Sysmex resolved to switch its reporting of Group consolidated financial statements from Japanese accounting standards and voluntarily adopt International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) from the fiscal year ending March 31, 2017. We will begin disclosing financial information based on IFRS from the first quarter of the fiscal year ending March 31, 2017.

In addition to Japan, the Sysmex Group is proactively developing its business in the Americas, EMEA¹, China and the Asia Pacific. Given this situation, we have decided to voluntarily adopt IFRS in the aim of enhancing convenience to Japanese and overseas shareholders and investors by facilitating the international comparability of our financial information in capital markets.
